REGULATIONS

EVENTS

The Men's Under 23 Championships
The Women's Under 23 Championships

VENUE

All matches will be played at the National Squash Centre in Manchester.

ELIGIBILITY

Any player shall be entitled to enter the championships provided:

- Ü They are Under 23yrs of age on 12 September 2004
- Ü That he/she is qualified to represent England, Ireland, Scotland or Wales on the closing date for entries.
- Ü That he/she has not competed in the National Closed Championship of a country other than England, Ireland, Scotland or Wales during the preceding or current year.
- Ü That Irish, Scottish or Welsh players are members of their National Association on the closing date for entries and English competitors are England Squash members for the 2004/2005 season.

FORMAT

Men's and Women's National Championships

The Men's draw size will be restricted to a maximum of 32.

The Women's draw size will be restricted to a maximum of 16.

Entries will be restricted according to England Squash rankings.

There will be no qualifying events.

All additional entrants will be placed on a reserve list.

Any player withdrawing at any time from the first round main draw will be replaced, if possible by a reserve.

England Squash reserve the right to reschedule matches at any time.

Playing Regulations

Point-a-rally scoring to 11 will be used for the Men's Under 23 Championship. International scoring (to 9) will be used for the Women's Under 23 Championship.

A 17" tin will be used for all Men's Under 23 matches.

A 19" tin will be used for all Women's Under 23 matches.

Competitors may be required to play at any time on any day of the Championships. England Squash reserves the right to alter this schedule.
